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1. INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the D-Tech Application Manager User Guide. The D-Tech Application Manager is used to download and install licenced D-Tech software products. This document details how to use the D-Tech Application Manager and will take you through the steps required to download and install the application, as well as how to activate licences for D-Tech's PC software and obtain access to the associated applications.

Before starting the process of downloading, please save any licence file(s) received to an accessible directory on your PC.

2. INSTALLATION

To install the D-Tech Application Manager, click on the link below, which should open your default browser and begin the download process. If that does not happen, please copy the entire text and paste it into the address bar of your web browser.

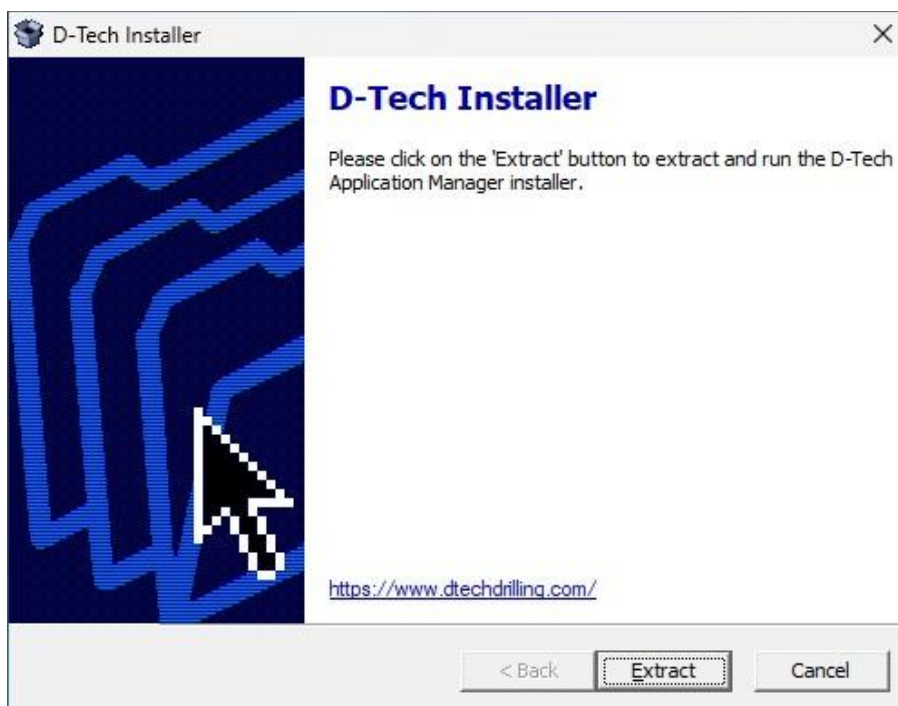
2.1. DOWNLOAD

Once the download is complete, navigate to the folder containing the downloaded file applicationmanagersetup.exe and double-click on this file.

At this point, dependent on your IT credentials, a prompt may appear requesting an Administrator username and password – please note that this username and password will relate to the IT security implemented by your company and you should contact your IT department to either provide elevated user access, or to enter credentials that will allow the application to run.

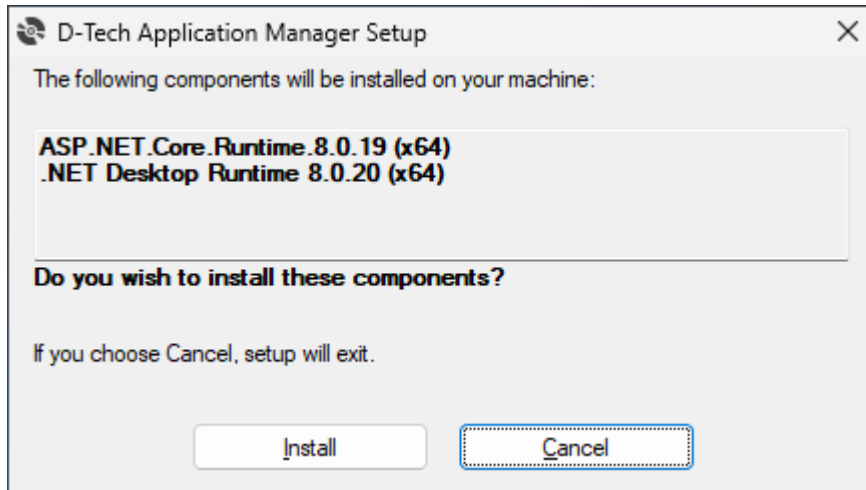
If your IT department did need to enter credentials for you at this stage, please be aware that they may need to be entered again along the process.

Click on the 'Extract' button when the window shown below is displayed, this will extract the D-Tech Application Manager installer and launch it.



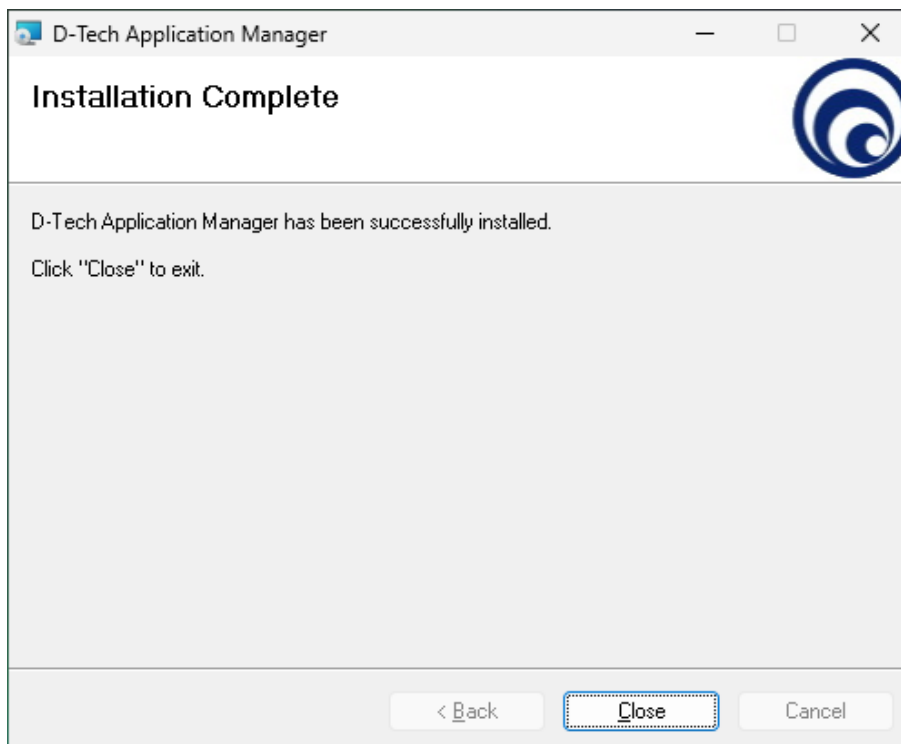
2.2. INSTALLING

Before the D-Tech Application Manager installation starts, Windows may prompt you to install some pre-requisite components. If it does, then a window like the one shown below will be displayed. Please click on the 'Install' button to ensure the D-Tech Application Manager can run correctly.



When the D-Tech Application Manager installer starts it will ask you to accept the terms of the D-Tech software licence agreement. Follow the instructions on each screen to complete the installation.

Once the software installation is complete the window shown below is displayed. Click on the 'Close' button to finish the process and exit the installation wizard.

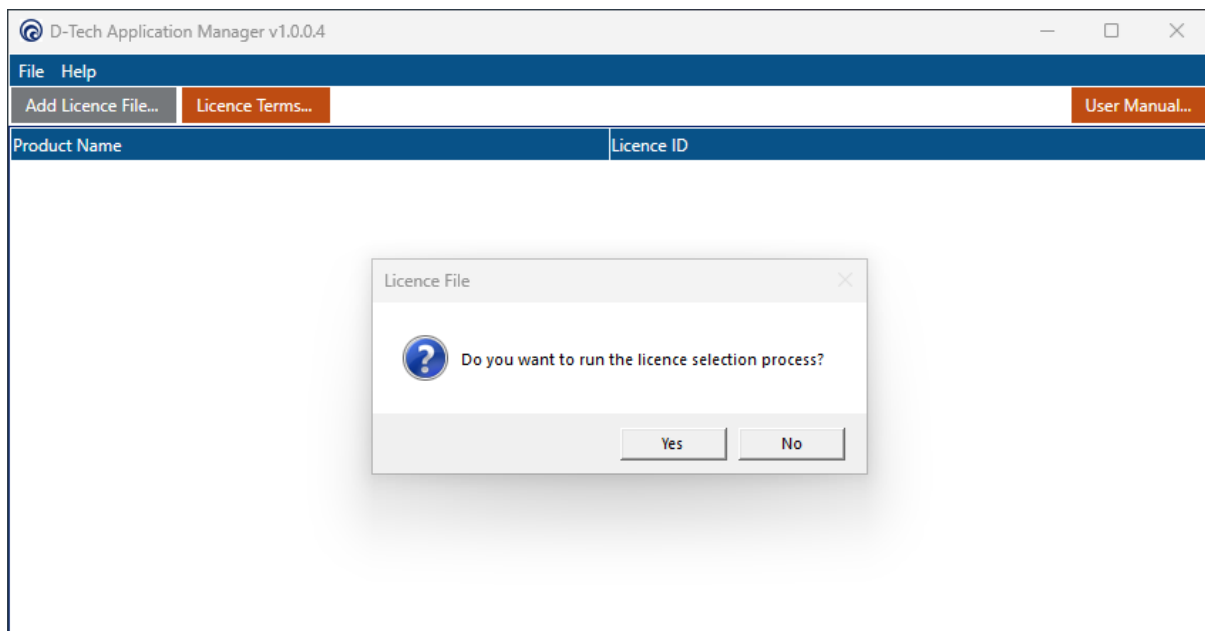


3. OPERATION

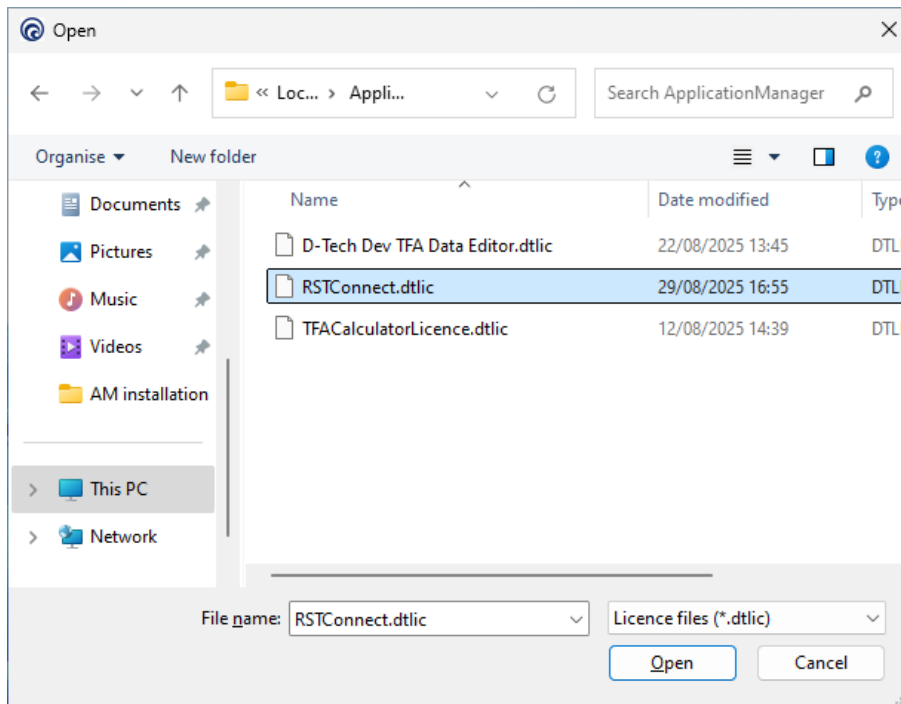
Once the installation process is complete, the D-Tech Application Manager will be launched automatically. To subsequently run the program, it can be launched using the desktop icon or start menu short cut that were created during the installation. Dependent on your IT credentials, a prompt may appear requesting an Administrator username and password – please note that this username and password will relate to the IT security implemented by your company and you should contact your IT department to either provide elevated user access, or to enter credentials that will allow the application to run.

3.1. FIRST USE

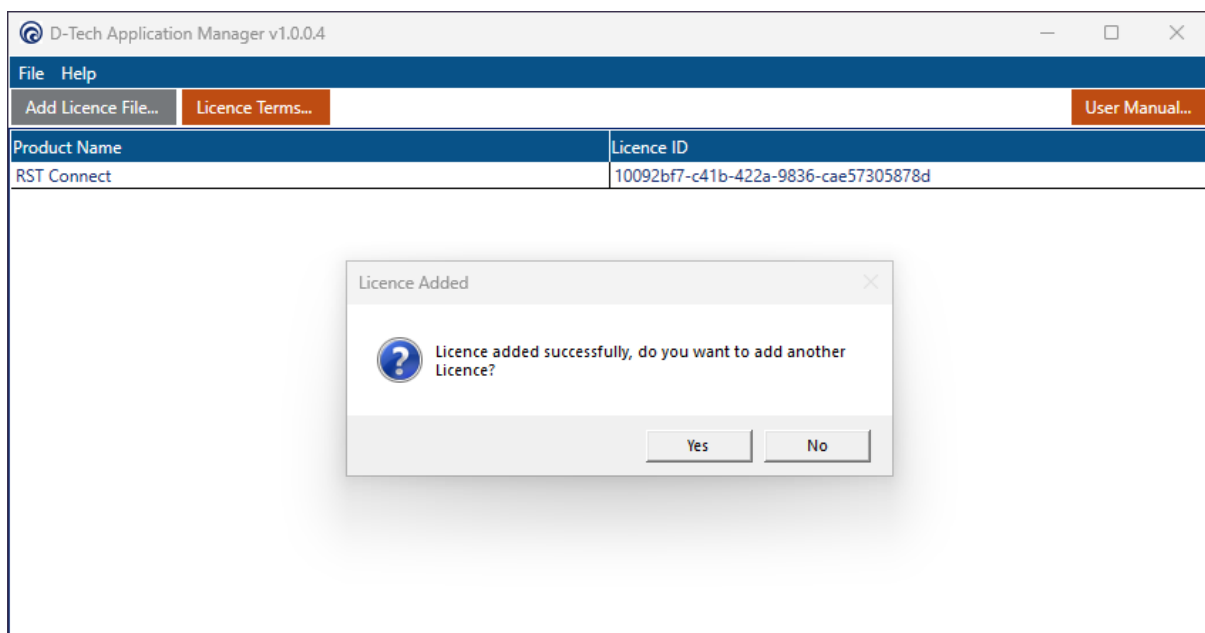
The first time the D-Tech Application Manager is used it will ask if you want to run the licence selection process as shown below. Please click on the 'Yes' button.



A file browser is displayed as shown below. Browse to the licence file you wish to install. Multiple licence files can be selected. Click the 'Open' button after selecting the licence file(s).



After selecting the licence file or files, the D-Tech Application Manager will display the product the licence file relates to in a list and asks if there are any additional licences that you wish to add as shown below. If all the licence files have already been selected click on the 'No' button to dismiss the prompt.

3.2. SUBSEQUENT USE

When the D-Tech Application Manager is launched it fetches the list of licences installed on the D-Tech Licence Server. It will then check if the software for each licence is installed and if not, it progresses to the next step – see section 3.3 below. Any software products that are already installed will display the status 'Already Installed'.

If you wish to add a new licence, click on the 'Add Licence File...' button.

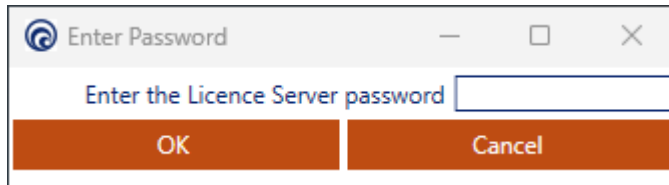
3.3. DOWNLOAD AND INSTALLATION

The D-Tech Application Manager calls the D-Tech cloud service to validate the selected licences and provided they are valid the installation package for the product is downloaded as shown below. It may take several minutes to download the installation package(s) depending on the performance of your PC and internet connection.

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Once all the packages have been downloaded the D-Tech Application Manager will install them one by one. When all the software installations are complete the D-Tech Application Manager adds any new licences to the D-Tech Licence Server. If the D-Tech Licence Server password has been changed the D-Tech Application Manager will prompt you for the password as shown below. Enter the password and click on the 'OK' button. Clicking the 'Cancel' button will skip adding the new licence(s) to the D-Tech Licence Server.

3.4. LAUNCHING SOFTWARE

The installed software can be launched from the D-Tech Application Manager by clicking on the 'Launch...' button for the relevant product as shown below. The D-Tech Licence Server can also be restarted by clicking on the 'Restart' button.

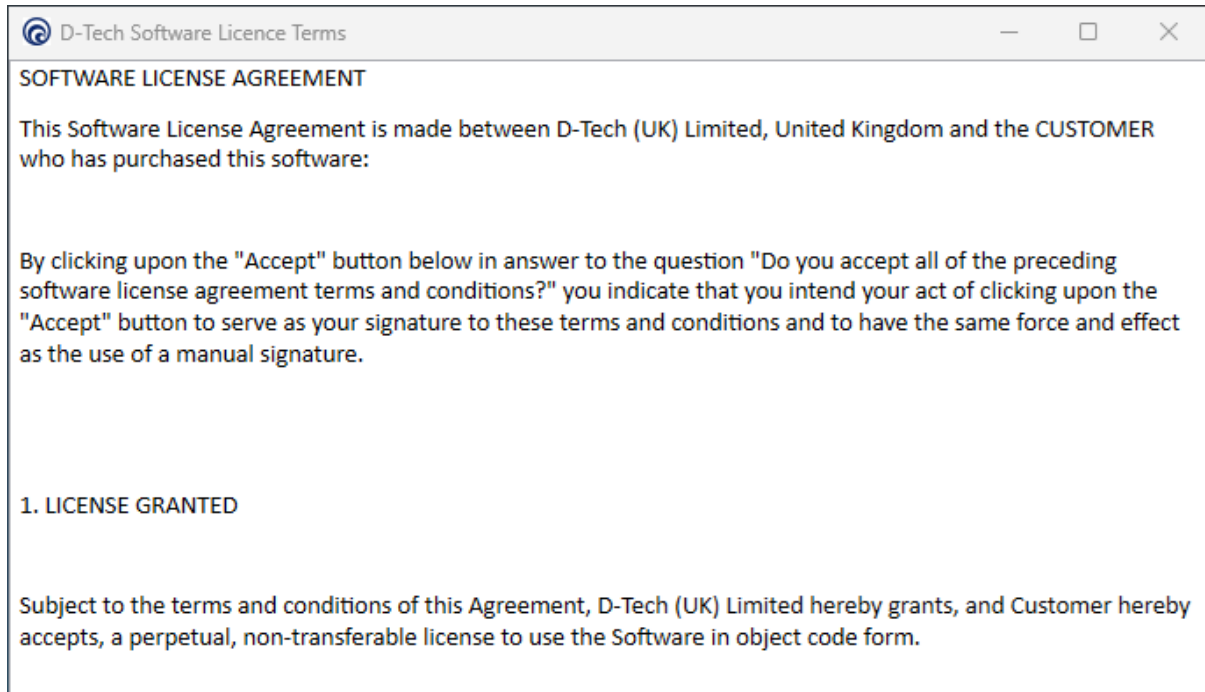

4.1. MENUS

4.1.1. FILE

4.1.1.1. ADD LICENCE FILE

Clicking this menu opens the file browser window.

4.1.1.2. EXIT

Clicking this menu or pressing Alt+F4 closes the D-Tech Application Manager software.

4.1.2. HELP

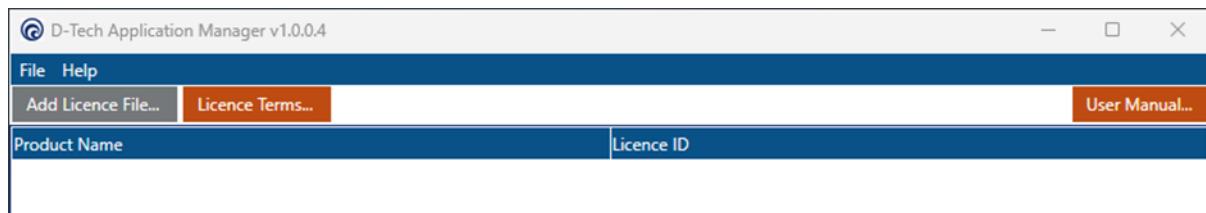
4.1.2.1. USER MANUAL

4.2.4. LICENCE TABLE

During the licence selection process the main window displays the licence data as shown below.

The data displayed in the table is as follows

- Product Name, the name of the D-Tech software from the licence file.
- Licence ID, the unique licence ID.

The data displayed in the table is as follows

- Product Name, the name of the D-Tech software from the licence file.
- Description, a description of the D-Tech software product.
- Status, the status of the download and installation of the software product.
- Progress, the progress of the download/installation and the action after installation.

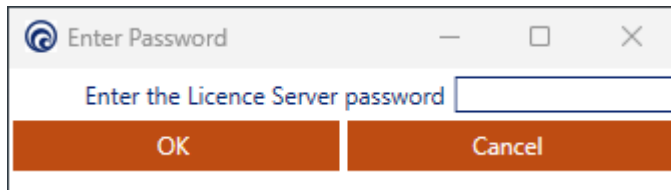
4.2.5.1. RESTART

Clicking this button restarts the D-Tech Licence Server.

4.2.5.2. LAUNCH

4.4. LICENCE FILE



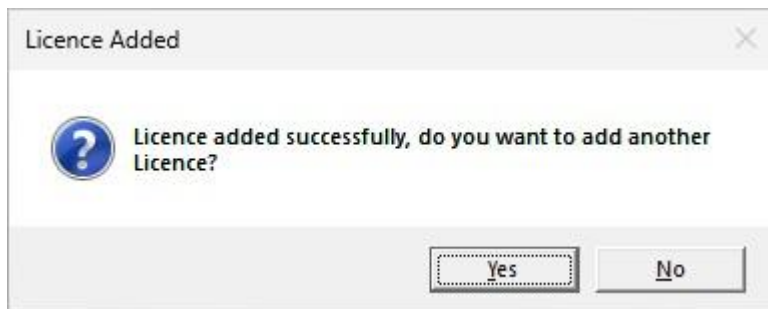
4.4.1. YES
